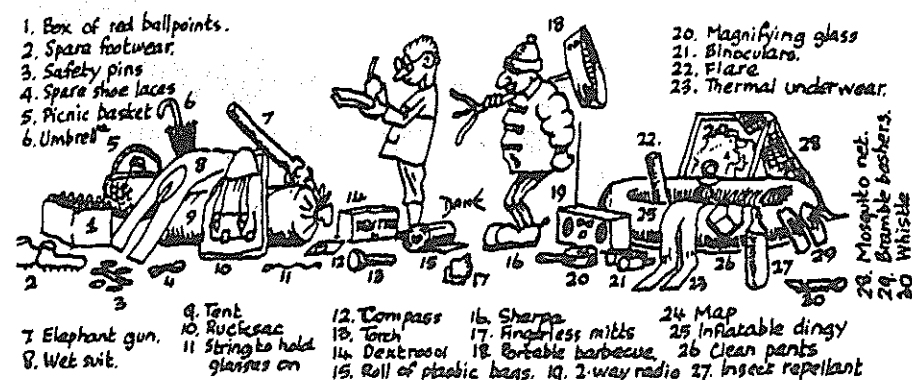

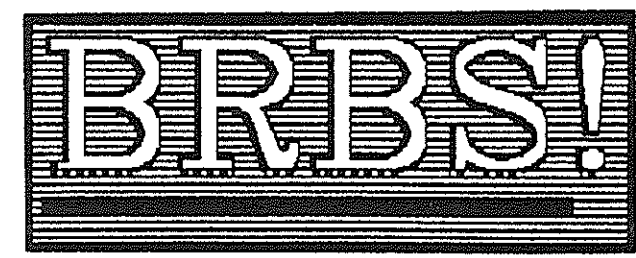
The winners are the first carload to finish the course with the most problems solved. Marvellous prizes are up for grabs.

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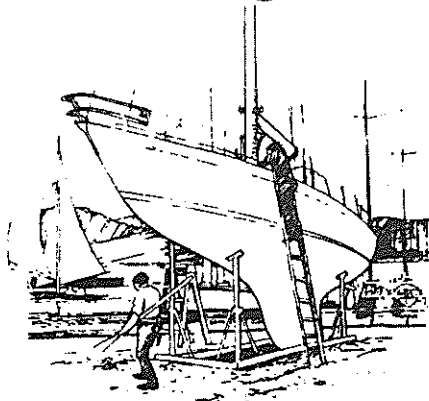
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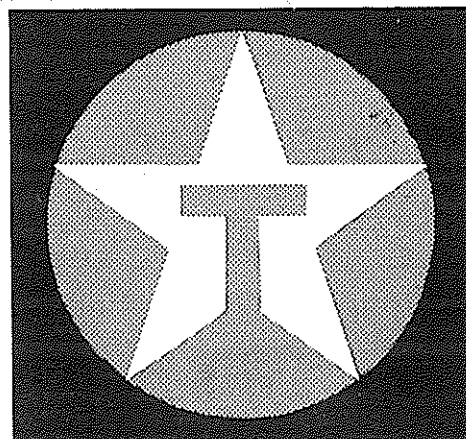
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
